Great cosmetic dentistry is not just a practice. It is an art. No one knows that better than R. Brad Beasley, D.M.D. founder of Beasley Cosmetic & General Dentistry. Dr. Beasley has been creating beautiful smiles and changing the lives of his patients for over 10 years.



Dr. Beasley is a 1996 graduate of the University of Alabama School of Dentistry. His private practice in Athens focuses primarily on cosmetic and restorative dentistry. He has completed multiple cosmetic dentistry, smile design, and occlusion post-graduate courses throughout the United States to learn the art of providing excellent

aesthetic dentistry. Dr. Beasley is also the vice-president of the Tennessee Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry and he is one of only eight “sustaining” members of the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry (AACD) in the State of Alabama.

Over the last three years, Dr. Beasley has entered the AACD’s International Smile Gallery Competition which is hosted annually in past locations such as Vancouver, Nashville, and San Diego. The competition is open to all 7600 AACD members and determines the best of the best in clinical cosmetic dentistry. To date, Dr. Beasley’s practice has won 11 medals for outstanding achievement in the practice of cosmetic dentistry. Dr. Beasley also holds more medals from the AACD than any other dentist in the State of Alabama. Each year, he looks forward to the competition. “It’s exciting because I’m able to take before and after photographs of patients whose cosmetic cases we’ve completed during the year and submit them anonymously for dentists selected from throughout the country to judge,” Dr. Beasley said.

Dr. Beasley also donates his talents through his participation in the AACD’s “Give Back a Smile” program. This program pairs a patient whose smile has been damaged by domestic violence and abuse with an AACD dentist. Dr. Beasley then volunteers his time and services to perform life-changing dental procedures for these victims to help restore their smile and self-confidence.

Recently, Dr. Beasley and his Give Back a Smile patient, Mary Browning, were featured on the front page of the Huntsville Times and Athens News Courier newspapers.

Dr. Beasley and his team are also proud to offer the latest in dental technology. One example is advanced cosmetic computer imaging. “The most encouraging thing for patients is to actually see how cosmetic improvements to their smile can dramatically improve their appearance before they decide to accept treatment,” Dr. Beasley said. “Now with only a patient photo and computer imaging we can show you what your new smile can look like in advance and that frequently helps our patients to better communicate what they like or don’t like.” Sedation is another advancement that has been a tremendous benefit to the practice of dentistry. “It is extremely safe and the patients are always carefully monitored,” Dr. Beasley said. However, because of the additional training and licensing required to perform oral sedation it is not offered routinely by dentists.
